

WPC Amenities Report August 2010

1. Dovehouse Sportsfield:

The dog ban/surveillance signs agreed at last weeks meeting have now been received and will be installed on Aug 2nd. The surveillance is now installed, and was operational from July 28th. (Brought forward due to suppliers holiday)

Sadly , the vandals have been in action again, this time they have snapped the top metal rail and broken the vertical support strips on the entrance gate to the field (Dovehouse Drive Gate). The gate is now in a dangerous condition and beyond repair.

Accordingly, I would ask councils approval, in order that I can arrange for a replacement gate to be fitted this week - at a cost of £125 +vat.

2. Dovehouse & Mountford Play Areas:

The Information & Safety signs agreed at last months meeting have been designed and ordered, and should be received this week, with installation following within the next two weeks.

Our intention to apply for the balance of our play equipment has been registered with WCC, as per last month's agreement.

3: Sports Club/Community Building:
