

Wellesbourne Parish Council
Amenities Committee Report March 2011

1. Dovehouse Play Area

We are still awaiting the quote from Phil Taylor at AGD Play Equipment for replacing the damaged parts/re-installing the spring animal that was vandalised last year.

2. Dovehouse Sports/Community Land

Following the work carried out by John Steadman to cut back the trees and the complaint from a resident. It has been agreed to allow the hedge to grow back but keep it tidy and against the wall to try and cover this up and make it look better. We are working with the Waster Depot to try and move/re position the flood light that has been exposed and shines into properties on Dovehouse Drive and hope to get this resolved in the next week. John Steadman will also be revisiting the site to tidy up the area and remove the tree stumps left.

3. Frost Road Play Area

Following a response from Greenbelt the 'Fast Sport' equipment they were proposing wasn't suitable for the play area. They are getting a quote to re install new toddler equipment. A site meeting maybe required once this is in with a represenitive of Greenbelt, a cross section of residents and possibly the community police to discuss and make final decision on whether play equipment should be re installed or the area should be landscaped.

4. Wellesbourne Sports & Community Centre

Tuesday 19th April is proposed as a clearing day the Sports & Community Centre a skip has been ordered and welcome anyone able to help lend a hand clearing rubbish into the skip. (Approx 8.30am-12.30pm). Please let me know if you are able to help.

We are looking at placing an advert into a Trade Magazine to ask for expressions of interest to develop the Sports & Community Centre.

Tender documents have been produced and are displayed on Parish notice boards and the website inviting tenders by 12th April 2011 for the repairs to the roof at the Sports & Community building. We hope to bring a proposal to be accepted at next months meeting

The following proposals are to be considered by the council:-

- *To write to SDC and ask for the release of £28,000 of section 106 money designated for sorts & community facilities in Wellesbourne. This money is to be allocated for capital spending on the proposed refurbishment of the Sports & Community Centre.*
- *To place an advertisement in Leisure Opportunities magazine (or a similar trade magazine) at a cost of no more than £700 asking for expression of interest in developing the Sports & Community Centre.*
- *To authorise the handy man for a further 3 hours work on the Sports & Community Centre.*

5. Sport Association

Following correspondence received from the Sports Association they are asking for help with the cost of the grass cutting this year.
