## **Sports/Community Building:**

The independent consultant has now been appointed to assist in progressing to stage two, with an open day for prospective contractors scheduled for Sept 5<sup>th</sup>

Final clearance of the interior items should be completed this week.

Orbit - Heart of England have offered to help with the stripping out of the building and possibly the electrics, as part of their community help programme.

Following this, a rodent control contractor and a structural survey will be required.

Repairs to the roof, guttering and lead are scheduled to commence on 3/8/11.

Quotations have now been received for the installation of a Broadband connection, and this will be progressed.

## **Play areas:**

Further reminder sent to Greenbelt re Frost Road bin and play issues.

Meeting arranged re Hammond Green shelter belt and play areas.

Complaint received re anti social dog behaviour at Mountford Play area – Dog Warden has visited, and spoken to person concerned. Further violations will result in prosecution.

## **Sports areas:**

## **Highways Issues:**

Awaiting WCC repair to hole left in grass verge, following work on chicane Newbold Road.

Uprooted Bollard near Chemists has been reinstated.
