TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A429 RED HILL, WELLESBOURNE

Warwickshire County Council propose to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing the above northbound lane of the road from the junction of A429 Red Hill and D6311 Red Hill Road northwards for a distance of approximately 950m, to all traffic. **This section of road will be closed to north bound traffic only.**

The Order will commence on 15 February 2012 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. **However, it is anticipated the (northbound) road will only be closed between 15 February 2012 and 9 March 2012.**

The closure is required for resurfacing works.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available:

For Northbound traffic only: A429 Ettington Road/Halford Road , B4455 Fosse Way , B4086 Friz Hill/Kineton Road , A429 Wellesbourne Bypass.

Traffic bound for Warwick/M40 will follow alternative directions avoiding Wellesbourne.
